On retirement Ben remained a member of the IPA and joined the retired officers association at which both he and Julie enjoyed attending the annual reunions over many years.

Ben leaves behind his wife, Julie, his two sons, Martin and Gordon and their spouses and two grandchildren, Sam and Caitlyn.
